SUBJECT: THE WAR ON DRUGS/MEXICAN DRUG CARTELS/NATIONAL SECURITY

OPERATION 'HOT TAMALE' *"REMEMBER THE ALAMO"*

As a casual observer, I wouldn't be taking a vacation in Mexico anytime soon.
